SKEPTICS HANDBOOK DELIVERED TO ALL POLITICIANS

Every politician in Australia yesterday received a copy of [The Skeptics Handbook](#) , a 16 page booklet outlining the fundamental flaws in the theory of man-made global warming.

“The Australian Climate Science Coalition is happy to have assisted in the Australian distribution of this informative and timely booklet” said William Kininmonth, science adviser to the ACSC.

The booklet, written by science media communicator, Joanne Nova from Western Australia has a print run of 150,000 copies which are being distributed to policy makers around the world.

“As the Senate prepares to debate the emissions trading legislation that will have an enormous effect on Australian jobs, but no effect on climate, senators need to pause and consider the recent science which undermines the theory of man-made global warming”.

“It is time to recognise, as some senators have already, that the theories, projections and modelling which seemed somewhat plausible in the early 1990’s do not stand scrutiny in light of recent science”.

“We are encouraging policymakers to have another look at the science and we are encouraging ordinary Australians to have their say at the online petition at www.listentous.org.au concluded Mr Kininmonth.

Polling by Roy Morgan Research in May 2009 underpins the ACSC view that as people become more informed on climate issues they no longer support man-made global warming theories.
